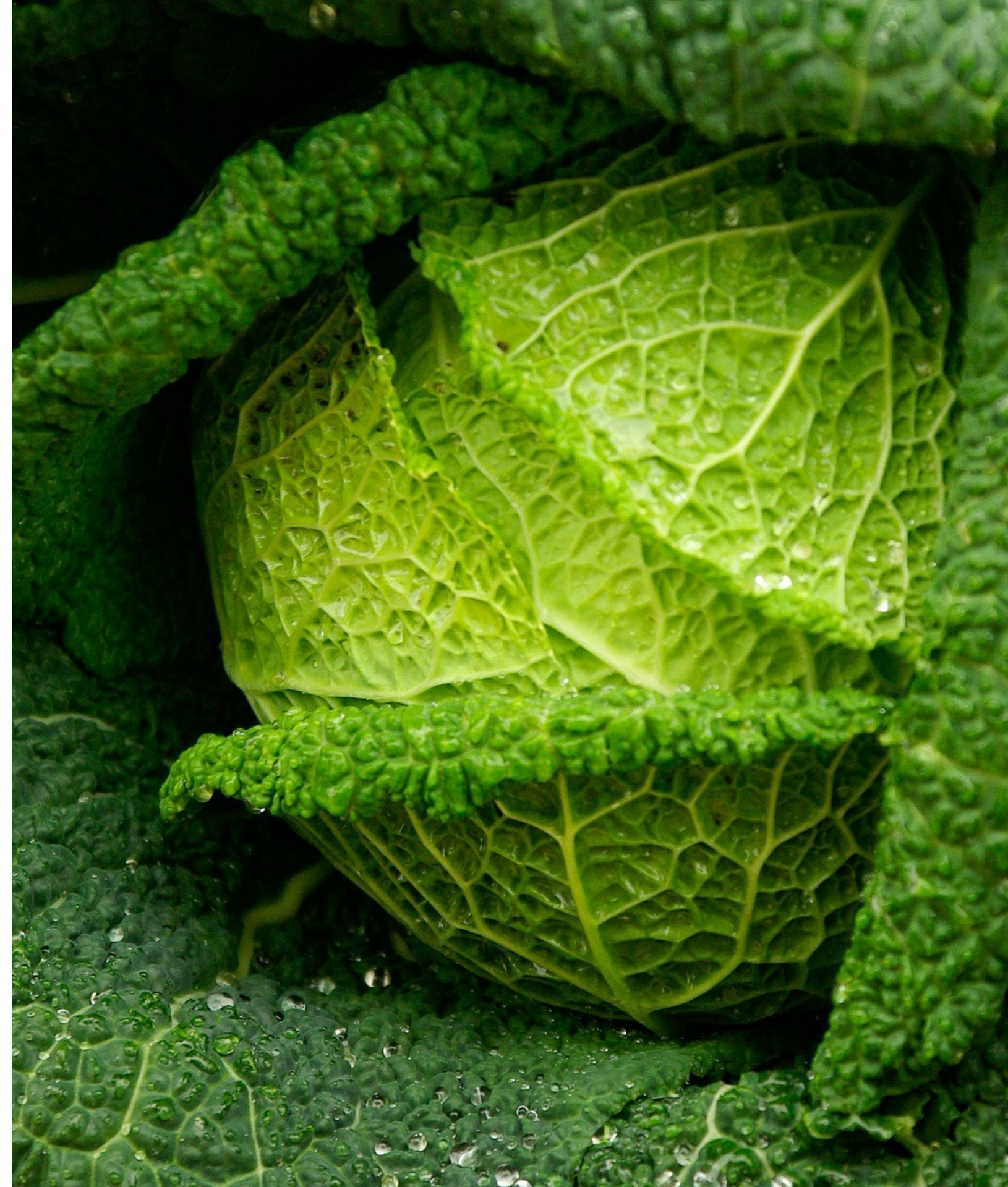
CHOOSING WHAT TO GROW

1. These are all great veggies to grow in the early spring, fall, or even straight through the winter
2. Remember that your winter veggies are pretty much all leaf and root veggies while your summer ones are mainly fruits and seeds



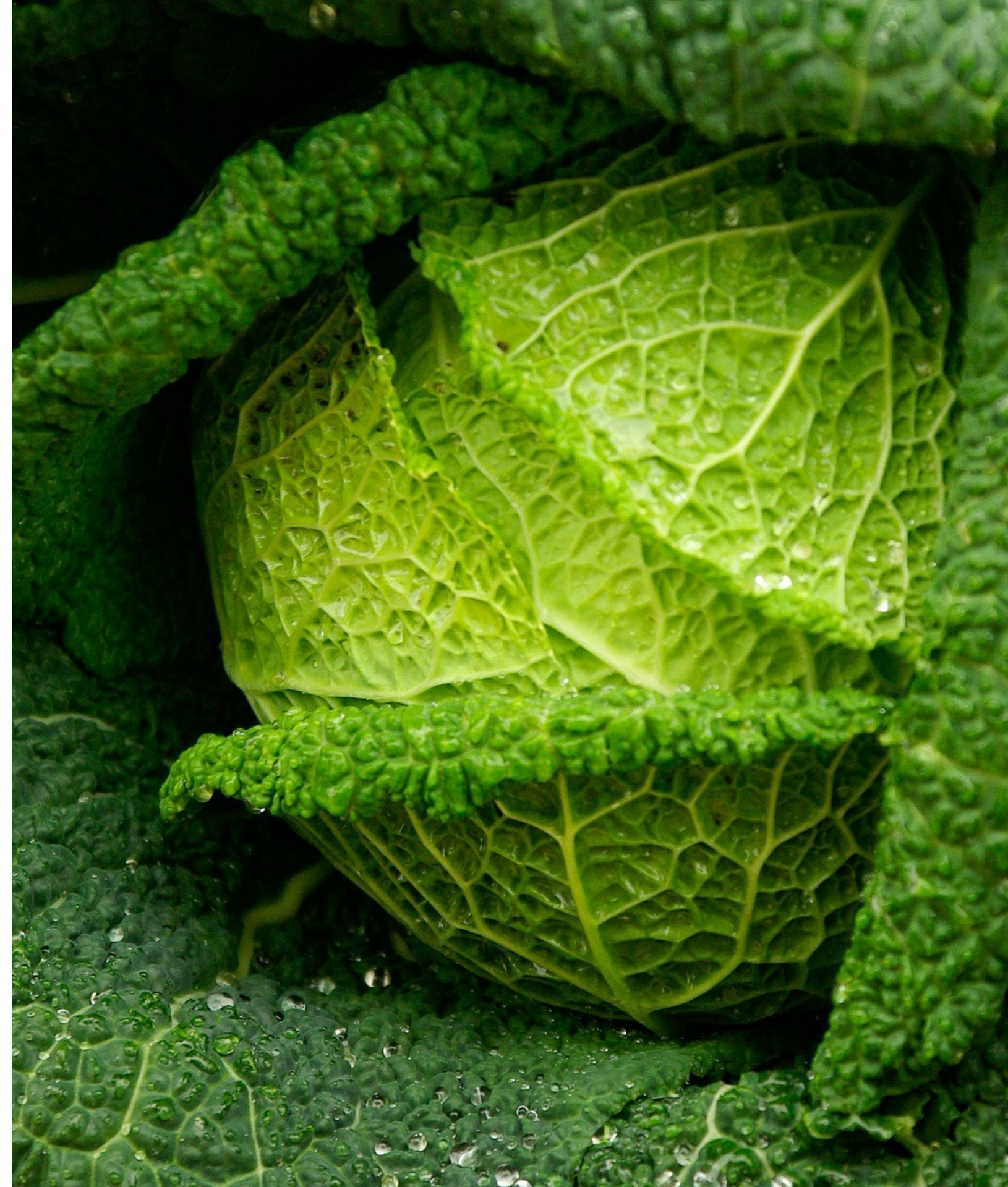
CHOOSING WHAT TO GROW

1. Make a list of what you would like to grow
2. Be as specific as possible
 1. Curly Kale
 2. Storage Cabbage
3. Choose the specific varieties you want to grow
4. Use open pollinated or heirloom seeds if you want to save seeds

TIMING YOUR FALL PLANTINGS

1. So, what is the single most critical factor for extending your season?
2. Great question and I think most of our minds would turn to heat or protection
3. But the biggest factor?
Timing.



TIMING YOUR FALL PLANTINGS

1. The first critical factor when it comes to season extension is the timing of when you plant your veggies
2. Timing can make all the difference from having a harvest – to no harvest at all



TIMING YOUR FALL PLANTINGS

1. So, what happens is as the weather gets cooler and as the day length decreases – plants growth slows down and will eventually come to a stop
2. As a general rule, plant growth slows down the most when days become 10 hours or shorter and temps drop



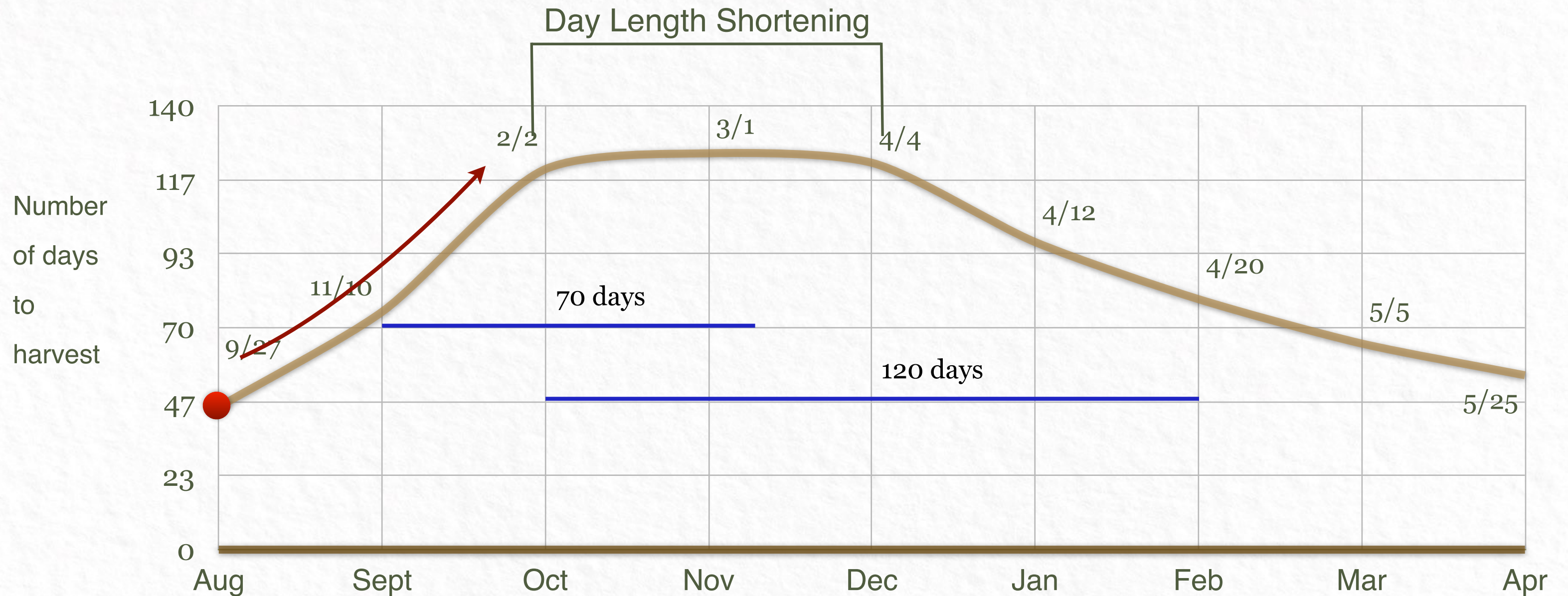


TIMING YOUR FALL PLANTINGS

- During this period in the winter your plants won't actually be growing very much and hence our purpose in fall/winter gardening is to get your plants started early enough so that they are mature by the time they stop growing (or slow way down)
- The critical factor then is to know when to plant your plants during the summer or fall so that they will be mature by the time winter sets in

TIMING YOUR FALL PLANTINGS

1. Timing is perhaps the #1 thing that causes most fall or winter gardens to fail
2. So, getting your plants started at the right time is critical to having a good fall and winter garden

PART 3: HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN PLANTING CALENDAR IN JUST MINUTES

THE PROBLEM WITH CROP PLANNING

1. You've got to:

1. Figure out when to plant your first crop
2. Then how long before it will be harvested
3. And how long of a harvest window you can expect from it
4. And then when to plant the second succession crop so that it is ready to go in when the first crop is harvested
5. Plus figure out how long in the season the crop can be grown
6. And then repeat that for each crop because they are all different
7. AND figure out how to map all of those crop times into your physical growing space!

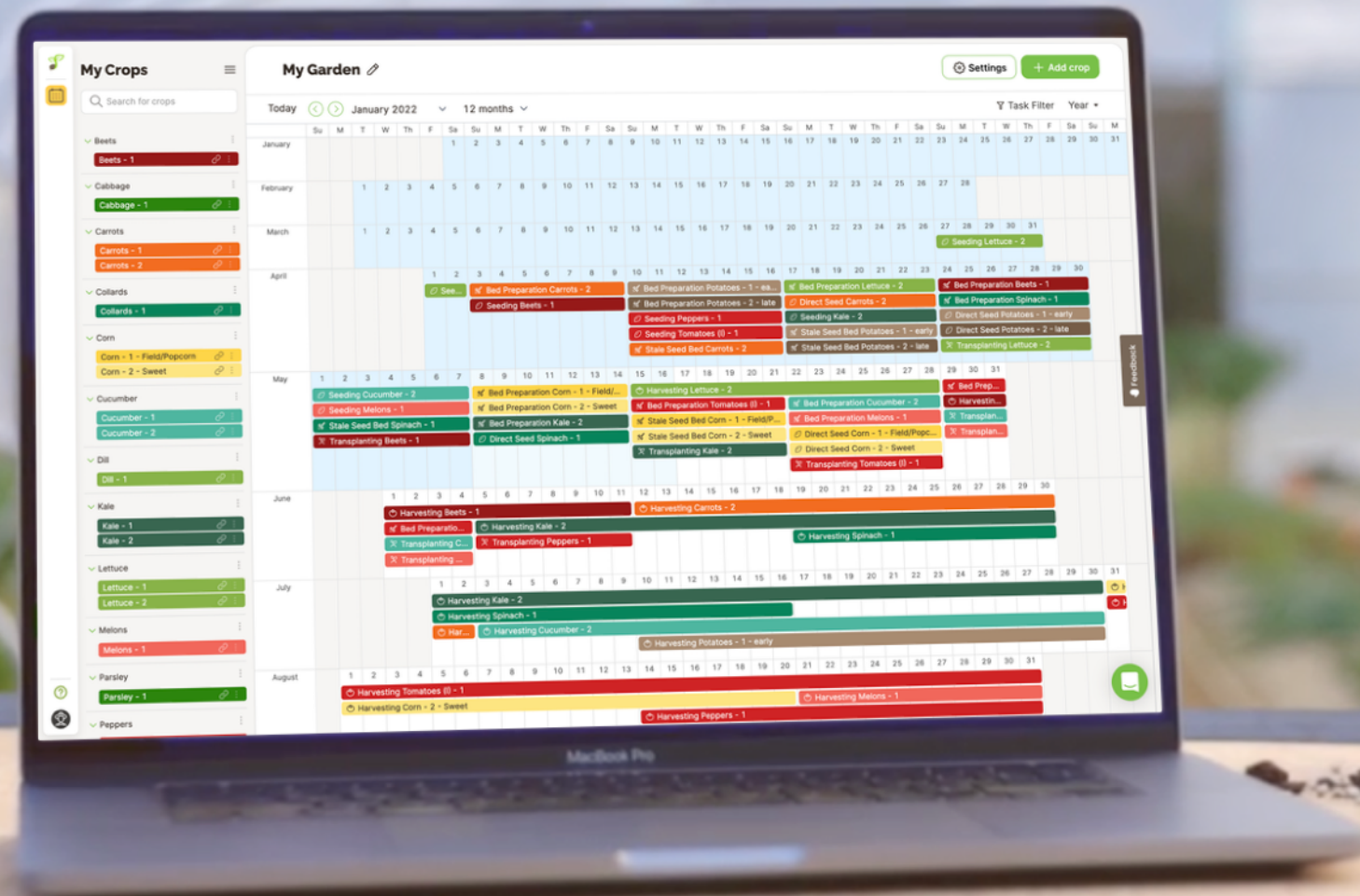
