THE PROBLEM WITH CROP PLANNING

1. You've got to:

1. Figure out when to plant your first crop
2. Then how long before it will be harvested
3. And how long of a harvest window you can expect from it
4. And then when to plant the second succession crop so that it is ready to go in when the first crop is harvested
5. Plus figure out how long in the season the crop can be grown
6. And then repeat that for each crop because they are all different
7. AND figure out how to map all of those crop times into your physical growing space!





1. **Fast growing cabbage** - swap out with other crop quickly to maximize return
2. **Lots of basil** - easy crop to freeze and pesto doesn't turn brown when using frozen basil
3. **Lots of green onions** - easy to freeze and use longer through the season
4. **Lots of radishes** - fresh pickle them for a delicious treat - our kids LOVED them!

1. Create Your Planting Plan


1. Find your average first and last frost dates
2. Use a tool/resource to find out when to seed based on your frost dates
3. Actually better to line up harvest dates for fall




STEP 2 – PLAN

1. 3 Steps to Create Your Plan

1. Enter spring plantings
2. Enter fall plantings
3. Fill the spaces in-between


1. We missed our fall planting times
2. Set better alarms
 1. Build warning alarms in Seedtime
 2. Set alarms on my phone



STEP 3 - MAP

3. Choose Where to Grow (mapping it all out)

1. Draw out your garden beds
2. Choose where each crop will grow
3. Implement a crop rotation plan
4. Adjust based on crop timings



STEP 3 – MAP

3. Layout tips

1. Think vertically and horizontally
2. Stack short crops under tall ones (use center main crop and companions on the side)
3. Don't leave any space unused
4. Cover the ground with living roots

1. Arrange beds North to South for more even lighting
2. Plan trellising to your advantage


